- 1. While folks are gathering, ask for volunteers to read how it works, Traditions and Promises.**
2. My name is _____ and I am an alcoholic. Welcome to the Tuesday English speaking meeting of A.A. in Merida. Let's open the meeting with a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer.

This is AA's preamble: Alcoholics Anonymous is a fellowship of men and woman who share their experience, strength and hope with each other that they solve their common problem and help others to recover from alcoholism. The only requirement for membership is the desire to stop drinking. There are no dues or fees for AA membership; we are self-supporting through our own contributions. AA is not allied with any sect, denomination, politics, organizations or institutions; does not wish to engage in any controversy, neither endorses nor opposes any causes. Our primary purpose is to stay sober and help others to achieve sobriety.
5. Is there anyone here who is attending their 1st or 2nd AA meeting?
6. Is there anyone here who is in their 1st thirty days of sobriety?
7. Is there anyone here who is returning to AA?
8. Are there any out of town visitors?
9. Are there any upcoming AA birthdays?
10. Are there any AA related announcements?
11. -Can I have someone read HOW IT WORKS from chapter 5 of AA's Big Book.
12. -Can someone read the Twelve Traditions.
13. The format of this meeting is we alternate reading from the Twelve and Twelve And then the following week from AS BILL SEES IT.
14. If anyone here has had a drink today, we ask that you just listen. Please meet up with someone after the meeting.
15. I would like to remind those attending that while someone is sharing that there be no cross talk.
16. This week we are reading from _____. (After the reading declare the meeting is now open for sharing.)
17. At 6:15 ask if there are any burning desires.
18. Our 7th Tradition States that we are self-supporting through our own contributions. It pays for rent, literature, and other expenses. Since we are not passing the basket, may I ask you to please consider going to aa.org and making a contribution. World Services needs our support. The place to contribute is right there on the home page.
